Community Projects

Israeli Identity

This program involves a candid and open encounter with Israeli society to strengthen immigrant youth's positive connections with the country. Included are workshops, lectures, educational excursions, seminars, and simulations that enable honest and genuine dialogue around topics connected to cultural identities and the difficulties with which immigrant youth grapple in their new society.

Support for at-risk Immigrant Youth

Conducted in immigrants' native languages, this program provides a safe haven in which youth can evoke the experiences connected to the crisis of immigration, and acquire skills and tools with which to face stress, and opens opportunities to connect with the community.

Hebrew Language Proficiency

This project assists immigrant students to learn and improve their Hebrew through subjects learned in school, and thus bolsters their academic success and integration into the educational system.

Drop-out Prevention

A triple-pronged approach to preventing school drop outs among immigrant youth by: increasing self-confidence; strengthening academic skills; improving Hebrew language skills. The project uses a variety of modalities to help immigrant children/youth cope better with difficulties, including include animal therapy, martial arts and others.

Prevention of Violence and Substance Abuse

This project provides a safe environment that allows immigrant youth to freely express their frustrations and anxieties. Youth are guided to examine their current perspectives and viewpoints and are offered information, tools and skills that help them cope with crisis situations and thus create new patterns of behavior.

Encounters between Cultures

These activities are geared for groups of immigrants from different countries, both new and veteran. Participants become familiar with the different cultures of group members, and learn respect and tolerance for the Other.

Developing Young Community Leadership

A program to empower young immigrants, strengthen their connections with the community, provide tools and resources for self-actualization, for helping others and improving the neighborhoods and towns in which they live.

Encounter with Judaism

An exploration of Jewish pluralism and the multiple cultures within Jewish life. Connecting young immigrants with Jewish heritage via art, holiday celebrations, and learning about tradition.

Educational-Therapeutic and Community Staff Development

Offering professional training for work with young immigrants.
